Those actions DO matter. Publicity helps build enthusiasm and attract attention from people who can help move a community forward. But see-through leadership also requires undertaking the tasks that social media followers don't see (or if they do, they're not impressed). Just like seethrough ministries of the church, those tasks might not have an immediate return, but they're vital to healthy leadership and transforming the health of a community.

What are the "see-through" tasks in your community and how will you handle them?

Under Texas Law, individuals who appear before a court and make a good faith effort to resolve their Class C Warrants are afforded safe harbor and not subject to arrest. Additionally, if a judgment is rendered against an individual who is unable to pay the judgment, the individual may request a judge to assess their ability to pay and offer alternative means to satisfy the judgment.

Once the arrest period begins, officers will aggressively seek out wanted individuals. Arrests can take place at any location, including the defendant's home, school, or workplace.


