## Robert Lee to hold two regular council meetings per month

The Robert Lee City Council met in regular session at 6 pm Tuesday, February 12, 2019. City Council members Ricky Green, Brandi Brosh, and Ann Hedges were joined by Mayor Allyson Crenshaw, City Secretary Crystal Blevins, and City Superintendent Billy Williams.

Following the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, they held a public hearing on the 2019/2020 Texas Community Development Block Grant Application.

Council members then discussed the Consent Agenda before passing. Council Member Ann Hedges questioned a charge from *The Observer/Enterprise* and was told it was for mandatory publication of Public Notices. She next questioned why the City of Robert Lee paid the Deputies with the Coke County Sheriff's Office as Ordinance Enforcement Officers.

Once into the regular agenda, council reviewed their regular meeting schedule. Due to the fact there are only three council members between now and May, special council meetings may not be held. For a special meeting, four council members must be present for it to be legal. With that in mind, council voted to set meeting dates for the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month. The next regular meeting of the Robert Lee City Council is set for February 26, 2019.

In discussion of the Audit, Mayor Crenshaw provided slides of transactions where receipts have not yet been found. These are listed in the boxes accompanying this article.
