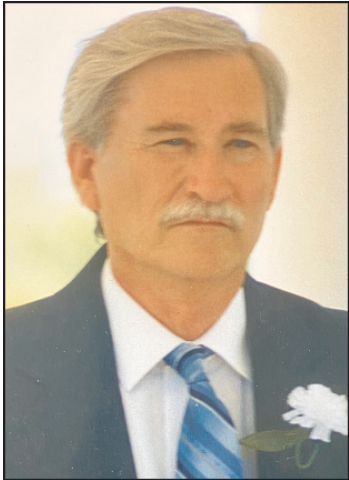

President Beverly Burdett called the meeting to order at 9:35 am, declared a quorum was present, and Houston McGuire gave the invocation. Board members present were Betty Lewis, Roma McCarley and Noel Tinkler. Houston McGuire, Administrator, Janie Munoz, BOM, and Roger Alexander, Consultant, were also present at the meeting.

The minutes of previous meetings, December 27 and January 10, were approved and there were no absentees from those meetings.

The administrator reported there is still a need for an LVN/ RN, and 2 CNAs. The facility is currently at 4-Star rating.

The census stands at 33 as of the meeting date, with 3 potentially pending.

Danco Electrical is still awaiting parts, there has been an air conditioning unit change over on the one of the units in the facility and the outside walk-in refrigerator has been replaced.

Cross HealthCare continues to be beneficial for the facility, and the 2022 audit has been completed. The MCR cost

report is complete and covid is over for the present, with no one in quarantine.

The QIPP report was given and it is progressing well.

Accounts receivable was discussed in depth and the financial statements were discussed and accepted.

Future agenda items were discussed and the next meeting will be February 28, 2023, at 9:30 am. The public is invited and encouraged to attend.

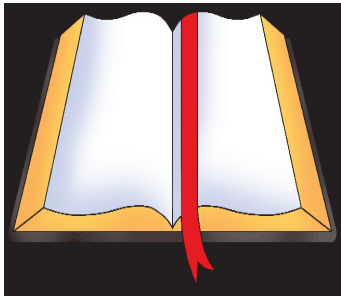
