New Proposed Foster Family Licensing Regulation

Today, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), through the Administration for Children and Families (ACF), announced a new proposed regulation to lessen obstacles in licensing standards for kinship foster caregivers. This proposed rule aligns with President Biden’s priorities on providing necessary resources to keep families together and support kinship care.

“The Biden-Harris Administration continues to prioritize keeping families safely together, including removing barriers for child welfare agencies to license grandparents, aunts, uncles, and other relatives and kin who step up to foster children during challenging times,” said HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra.



“As this new proposed regulation gives states and tribes the ability to adopt separate licensing standards for relatives and other

kin, we encourage agencies to place as few burdens as possible on kin, consistent with the safety and well-being of the child.”
