Early voting for March primary election to run through February 28

Early voting for the March 3, 2020, primary elections began on Tuesday, February 18, 2020, and runs through Friday, February 28, 2020. Coke County elected offices to be decided in 2020 include Commissioners Precinct 1 and 3. These positions are currently held by Donald Robertson and Marshall Millican respectively.

Others to be decided and their current office holder are County Attorney (Nick Arrott), Constable (Marty Boyd), Tax Assessor/Collector (Josie Dean), and Sheriff (Wayne McCutchen).

All incumbents have filed to retain their seats and Constable Marty Boyd will be joined on the ballot by Billy Williams.
