A food handlers course by the Texas accredited Department of State Health Services is being offered by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in Coke County, Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Office Food Safety - It's In Your Hands is available upon request.

This 1-2-hour course will now be required for all food service employees to help promote the service of safe food. The certificate is good for 2 years and is valid anywhere in the State of Texas. The course is a basic A&M overview of food safety practices Service are open to all people

employees to complete an cross contamination, and time and temperature abuse.

> To request a class, please call the Extension office at 325-453-2461. Registration can also be done in-person the day of the course. The cost is \$20 per person and must be paid in full before the course begins. The class is taught in English, but Spanish handouts are available if requested in advance.
