The Coke County Commissioners Court met in special session February 13, 2014, at the courthouse in Robert Lee. Members of the court present included County Judge, Roy Blair, Commissioner, Pct. #1 Troy Montgomery, Commissioner, Pct. #2 Wendell Lee, Commissioner, Pct. #3 Gaylon Pitcock, Commissioner, Pct. #4 Bobby Blaylock. Clerk Mary Grim was also in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer given by Comm. Lee and pledge to the flag was recited.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.

The Court discussed the leasing of the Coke County Juvenile Detention Center. The tenant/purchaser will be Cline Housing Co., LLC and not Garrison General Contractors, LLC. Commissioners asked that they get the definition of occupation of building and exterior of the building. After the six (6) month lease is up, the County will list the property with a broker for thirty (30) days. Garrison will have the right to match the offer that Coke

County gets. Any modifications made to the building will have to be approved by Commissioner's Court.

Comm. Blaylock made a motion to allow Judge Blair to continue in lease/purchase options with Mr. Garrison to proceed to the next step which is drawing up a lease contract. The motion was seconded by Comm. Montgomery. Motion carried.

The Coke County Commissioners Court met in special session February 18, 2014, at the courthouse in Robert Lee. Members of the court present included County Judge, Roy Blair, Commissioner, Pct. #1 Troy Montgomery, Commissioner, Pct. #2 Wendell Lee, Commissioner, Pct. #4 Bobby Blaylock. Clerk Mary Grim was also in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer given by Comm. Blaylock and pledge to the flag was

recited.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum. Comm. Pitcock was absent.

Judge Blair reported that he visited with the attorney and Mr. Garrison. He would like to lease and do due diligence. The definition of occupation is when he has five (5) people in the building. Once it becomes leased and occupied with five (5) people, the rent will go from \$1,000.00 to \$3,500.00 a month and the Court will make a decision on which broker to list with for thirty (30) days.

Comm. Montgomery made a motion to allow Judge Blair to have attorney draw up lease according to terms as discussed. Motion was seconded by Comm. Lee. Motion carried.

Judge Blair recessed the meeting at 9:10 am for no longer than 72 hours.
