Early voting for primary election ends today

Early voting for the March 3, 2020, primary election ends today, Friday, February 28, 2020. Coke County elected offices to be decided in 2020 include Commissioners Precinct 1 and 3. These positions are currently held by Donald Robertson and Marshall Millican respectively. Others to be decided and their current office holder are County Attorney (Nick Arrott), Constable (Marty Boyd), Tax Assessor/Collector (Josie Dean), and Sheriff (Wayne McCutchen). All incumbents have filed to retain their seats and Constable

Marty Boyd will be joined on the ballot by Billy Williams. Polling will be held on election day, Tuesday, March 3, from 7 am until 7 pm at the following locations:

This course is ANSI-CFP accredited and includes Certified Professional Food Manager examination (CPFM) Prometric Exam and "Food Safety: It's Our Business"

course book.

This course teaches managers about food safety, sanitation, food flow, HACCP, and managing the operation. This course will help understand major causes of food borne illness and how to prevent them, boost employee morale by increasing their professionalism, improve relationships with health officials, receive information in order to train your staff on-site, increase food safety knowledge of your employees and upon passing the certification examination, you will fulfill state requirements for Certified Food Manager status.
