West Coke County Hospital Board Meeting

By Pat Stephens The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session January 30, 2012. President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order at 9:38 am, and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Mary Bessent, Sarah Green, Pat Stephens, and Dessie Kendall. Also present were Roger Alexander, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, Business Office Mgr. There were no visitors. Roger Alexander gave the invocation. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved, and absent members were excused from the December meeting.

In the staffing update, Roger informed the Board all positions in the staff are currently filled, but there is a continuing need for prn CNA's and nurses for shift work. Roger also reported there are currently 12 residents in the Alzheimer's Unit, and 52 residents total in the Care Center as of the meeting date.

The Board then discussed capital projects. Roger reported plans are currently being reviewed with Templeton Construction for the renovation of the Alzheimer's Unit. In preparation to start the renovation, the entire building was surveyed for asbestos. Some was found on some of the pipes to be removed to make room for the new water lines. This will be addressed before work can progress. Roger is also taking bids, as requested by the Board, for hall floor covering and window replacement for the lobbies.



The Board broke for lunch (pork chops and all the trimmings....yum!) from 11:50 to 12:37.


The Board discussed in depth the updates to the employee handbook. Copies were given to the Board to review, and there will be a special called meeting at a later date to complete and implement the new guidelines.
