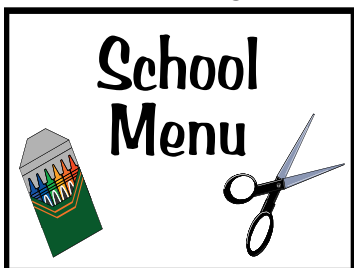


BRONTE SCHOOL NEWS

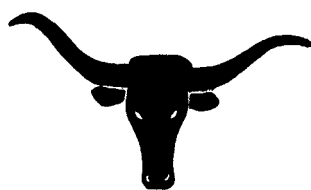
