Competitive formal bids will be received for removal of materials existing and construction of a 'low water This crossing is crossing'. located on Salt Creek near the Edith community in Coke County, and is named the Springs Crossing. Dripping the existing Removal of roadbase and disposal of all the materials will be included. Contractor will then construct a low water crossing. As defined herein; contractor will cut, remove, and haul off existing down to existing asphalt concrete pad, and cut other existing asphalt and road material down to 8 inches below grade, remove, and haul off; then install a concrete pad with a minimum of 5000 psi concrete with a heavy broom finish 8" thick with 5/8"rebar tied in every 18"X 18". An 8"X 8" concrete footer with 4, 5/ 8"rebar bars linearly installed in the footer will be incorporated along the exterior below the 8 inch pad, where possible. Cement apron will be installed, the width of the creek bed, on stream the upper side.

Dimensions of the concrete slab to scale the low water crossing will be 20' by 200'. The TFB Young Farmer & Rancher Enrolled College Student scholarship offers three \$2,000 scholarships to students pursuing an undergraduate degree in an agriculture major.

College students pursuing a degree in Agricultural Education can apply for the Mia Student Teaching Balko Scholarship. Four senior agricultural education students will receive scholarships each semester. The scholarships, valued at \$1,500, aim to help students cover expenses during their semester of off-campus

student teaching. Students who will be student teaching offcampus in fall 2022 are encouraged to apply.

TFB's S.M. True Jr. Agricultural Scholar Award offers \$20,000 total to a deserving student who is at least pursuing а junior an undergraduate degree in an agriculture major.

The Rural Veterinary Scholarship is new this year. Four scholarships valued at \$10,000 each will be awarded. To be eligible for the scholarship, students must be a second or third-year veterinarian student at Texas A&M University or Texas Tech University with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. The applicant must also plan to enter a rural and/or food animal practice in Texas after graduation.

TFB also has made scholarship funds available to first-year and enrolled students attending Texas State Technical College (TSTC). Twenty-five \$1,000 scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis through the Texan Success Scholarship. Another \$10,000 is available through the "helping hands" scholarship, which is meant to help students with unexpected costs that are not usually covered by traditional scholarships. TSTC scholarships are available at https:// www.tstc.edu/admissions/ financial-aid/scholarships/.

"These scholarships and awards are another way county Farm Bureaus and Texas Farm Bureau invest in the future of our community, state and Texas agriculture," John Ross said.

TFB scholarship applications are due online by March 1,

2022, and County Farm Bureau scholarships are due to the county office by April 1, 2022.

Re-register Texas cattle brands, marks, tattoos by Feb. 28

By Julie Tomascik The deadline to re-register Texas livestock and equine brands, marks and tattoos is fast approaching. Brand owners have until February 28 to complete the re-registration process.

"Even if the brand has been in your family for generations, it must be re-registered," Tracy Tomascik, TFB associate director of Commodity and Regulatory Activities, said. "It's important to take care of this re-registration process prior to February 28. The registration is good for 10 years and will expire August 30, 2031."

previously recorded Anv brands, marks and tattoos that have not been re-registered by the deadline will be considered unclaimed and eligible for registration by another.

Brands are registered through the county clerk's office. Some offices are participating in an online re-registration program. It is best to contact the county clerk to see if the county is participating.

Brand applications and renewals require a drawing of the brand that notes the location on the animal.

"The brand location is just as important as the brand," Tomascik said.
