Counties offer hunter appreciation barbecues

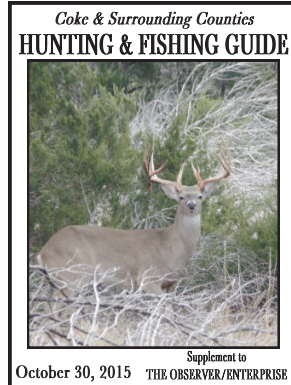
