The annual barbecue has grown from about 300 the first year to as many as 1,000 hungry hunters.



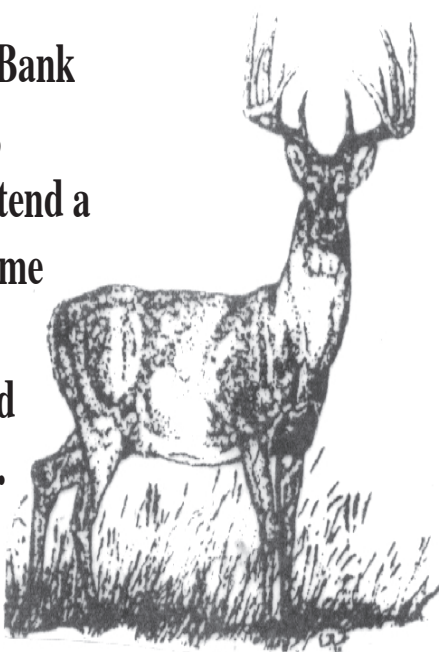
