Potential candidates in the filing deadline; upcoming May 11, 2012, local entity election may file for their place on the ballot of election until Friday, March 1, 2013.

There are two two-year city council member terms on the ballot for the City of Bronte. Currently, these offices are held by Misti Bedford and Paula McWright. Both women have filed for reelection.


