Clerk Mary Grim was also in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer given by Comm. Williams and pledge to the flag was recited.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.

Comm. Montgomery made a motion to approve the minutes for February 24. The motion was seconded by Comm. Williams. Motion carried.

No action was taken on the burn ban.
