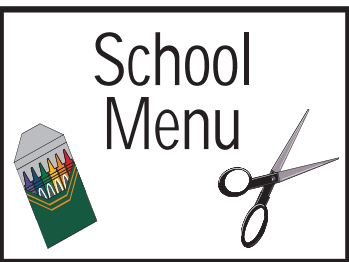

Deer Study Group to meet April 10-11

The Texas Deer Study Group will convene April 10-11, 2014, at the Knights of Columbus Hall in Columbus, Texas. This year's event will focus on "Great Expectations: Optimizing Deer Management in the Post Oak Savanna and Gulf-Coast Prairies."

The program will consist of a full day of presentations on the 10th covering a wide array of topics including a history of management and habitat changes in the area, breeding chronology and buck movement, harvest strategies, an overview of research and a point-counterpoint discussing important management concerns.

On the 11th, the group will meet at a local ranch for a half-day of presentations covering getting to know your deer, habitat management techniques and native and introduced vegetation. Everyone with an interest in deer and deer management is encouraged to attend.
