

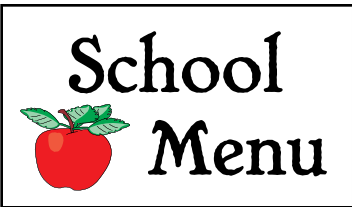
**Artist to speak at WTRC benefit**
