

Bronte ISD Board minutes posted

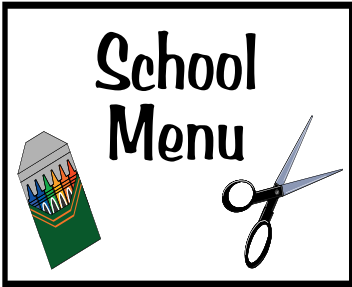
The Bronte ISD Board of Trustees held a Regular Board Meeting on Thursday, March 21, 2013, at 7 pm. Those in attendance were: Paul Williams, Blake Braswell, Shane Kelton, Ray Barnett, Kay Styles, David McWright and Alan Richey, Superintendent. Also present were David Bedford, Secondary Principal and Donna Poehls, Elementary Principal. Others present included Maureen Youngblood, Heather Middleton and Jeanna Lee. Jay Henderson was absent.

The meeting opened in prayer by Ray Barnett

The minutes were approved for the February 21, 2013, Board meeting.

There were no audience items.

The Principals reported the following enrollment: Elementary – 131, Secondary – 138; Total enrollment – 269. Mr. Bedford updated the board on the High School activities including FFA Judging and Spring Sports. Testing will begin April 1 and Bronte will host the Jr. High District Track meet on April 9.

Board members cast ballots for candidates for ESC Region XV Board of Directors. They approved Gina McCutchen as Early Voting Clerk. Early Voting will begin April 29, 2013, at the School Administration Office. The Board also approved Update 96 as presented. All were in favor.

Mr. Richey, Superintendent, presented an update on several financial issues and informed the Board that the Ag pickup had been ordered. He also updated the Board on the Elementary roof repair and the upcoming Site Based Retreat set for April 22.

The Board approved a Reduction in Force due to Program Change in all Bronte ISD areas. All were in favor.

The Board was also informed CKC (local) Policy, Emergency Operations Plan has been processed.

The March 2013 bills were approved. All were in favor.

The Board went into Executive session at 8:05 pm and resumed the Regular meeting at 9:05 pm.

The Board approved a Part-time position for Title-I Programs and to extend Secondary and Elementary Principal's Contracts. All were in favor.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:09 pm.
