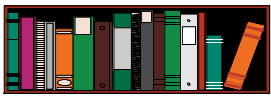


Robert Lee Cheerleaders selected

RLISD Board post minutes

The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met in regular session on Thursday, March 21, 2013, in the Robert Lee ISD Conference Room 119 at 5 pm. The meeting was called to order by Vice President Brosh.

The members present included Brandi Brosh, Jeffie Roberts, Beverly Sinclair, Tracy Allen and Tom Sawyer. Wes Washam and Irma Torres were absent.

The invocation and pledge were led by Jeffie Roberts.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the minutes of February 21, 2013, seconded by Tracy Allen. All voted for.

Tracy Allen made a motion to accept the financial report as presented by Robin Allen and to pay the bills, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for.

Cary Reese with W.B. Kibler along with Joe Spoon attended the meeting to present Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Athletic Complex. Tracy Allen made a motion to give Supt. Hood authorization to sign for GMP with requested changes. The motion was seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Matters related to 2012 Construction Project were discussed.

Wayne Simpson gave the high school report. High School enrollment for grades 7-12 was 102 and ADA was 95.1% for the month of February. The report for elementary listed Elementary enrollment for February at 133 students and 95.5% ADA.

Wayne Simpson presented the annual SHAC Report for RLISD.

Supt. Hood recommended signing service agreement with Interquest Detection Canines of West Texas for 2013-14. A motion was made by Jeffie Roberts and seconded by Tom Sawyer to approve the recommendation. All voted for.

Tracy Allen made a motion to approve a recommendation from Supt. Hood to adopt the RLISD Technology Plan for 2012-2015. The motion was seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the Local Policy Manual Update 96 as presented by Supt. Hood. Tracy Allen seconded the motion. All voted for.

Discussion was held on CKC (Local) Safety Programs/Risk Management: Emergency Plans

The Board discussed procedures to allow trained employees to carry concealed fire arms on school grounds. No action was taken, but the policy will be discussed at later meetings.

Supt. Hood gave his respective report on enrollment numbers, an update on Legislative session, a facilities update and CSCOPE and a thank you note.

Tracy Allen made a motion, seconded by Beverly Sinclair, to renew 10 month term contracts for employees as presented for the 2013-2014 school year; Dana Cauley, Lara Gott, Kevin Meek, Elena Sanchez, Celeste Service, Audrey Devoll, Katherine Drennan, Frankie Gartman, Mary Ann Hill, Maranda Hood, Sterling Myers, Amber Palmer and Susan White; Multi

Supt. Hood recommended signing resolution to the Cafeteria Plan offered by RLISD, changing the maximum amount of flexible spending accounts. Tracy Allen made a motion to approve the resolution for RLISD Cafeteria Plan, seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended signing a contract with ESC XI for RLISD Web Hosting for 2013-2014. Jeffie Roberts made the motion to approve the contract, seconded by Tracy Allen. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended appointing Mary Beth Drennan as election judge for the RLISD School Board Election. Beverly Sinclair made the motion to approve this recommendation. The motion was seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Assignment 10 month term contract for Wayne Alexander, Kerry Gartman, Billy Whyburn; 11 month term for Jeff Brisbin, Sandy Sawyer, Denise Roberts; 10 Month Probationary Contract for Vianna Madrid, Kelly Avants, and Bree Sherwood. All voted for.

The next meeting for the RLISD School Board will be held Monday, April 22, 2013, at 5 pm.
