**Fund gathers donations for wildfire victims**

Nearly half a million acres of the Texas Panhandle burned. Homes, barns and fences burned. Some lost livestock. Others lost their lives.

Now that the fires are out, farmers, ranchers and landowners are working to rebuild. But they need help.

"Some people lost everything," John Ross Copeland, Coke County Farm Bureau president, said. "To help our neighbors get back on their feet, Texas Farm Bureau (TFB) has developed a Panhandle Wildfire Relief Fund for tax-deductible donations to meet the needs in the Panhandle."

Following the fires, farmers and ranchers from across Texas and neighboring states trucked hay and other donations to the Panhandle. As of March 13, hay
