place on Wednesday, March 25, and Thursday, March 26, beginning 8:30 am until 5 pm at the Texas A&M AgriLife Research and Extension Center in San Angelo.

This course is ANSI-CFP accredited and includes Certified Professional Food Manager examination (CPFM) Prometric Exam and "Food Safety: It's Our Business" course book.

This course teaches managers about food safety, sanitation, food flow, HACCP, and managing the operation. This course will help understand major causes of food borne illness and how to prevent them, boost employee morale by increasing their professionalism, improve relationships with health officials, receive information in order to train your staff on-site, increase food safety knowledge of your employees and upon passing the certification examination, you will fulfill state requirements for Certified Food Manager status.

Texas, Our Texas

On February 28, 1836, Texas settlers were revolting against Mexico and had engaged in skirmishes and battles across Texas for five months. Around 185 men, led by William B. Travis and James Bowie, were under siege at the Alamo in San Antonio. Forty-one delegates arrived at Washington-on-the-Brazos (near present-day Brenham) for a convention to discuss Texas' independence.

On March 1, the convention came to order and a committee was appointed to draft a Declaration of Independence. The U.S. Declaration of Independence, signed in 1776, had been a laborious effort. The Continental Congress had been in session for months and

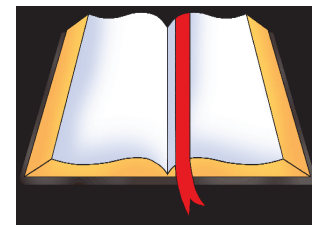
