Concho Valley Electric Cooperative to award four scholarships

Concho Valley Electric Cooperative will award four \$2,000 scholarships this spring. Two scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors, and two more scholarships will be awarded to students at other points in their education.


Applicants must be a CVEC member whose primary residence is served by the cooperative or a dependent of a CVEC member whose primary residence is served by the co-op. Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on grades,

leadership ability, community involvement, school activities and essay submission. Permissible uses of scholarship funds include payment of tuition, fees, books, supplies and other equipment required for courses of instruction. The recipient must attend an accredited Texas institution of higher education, including certified trade schools, while pursuing a degree.

Recipients must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA and enroll for a minimum of 12 hours to be

considered a full-time student. Half of the scholarship will be awarded at the beginning of the fall semester, and the remainder will be awarded at the beginning of the spring semester.


