(Continued from page 1) Mandatory Watering Schedule is now in effect. There can be no outside watering between the hours of 10 am and 8 pm. However, watering is permitted at anytime if it is by means of hand-held hose, faucet filled bucket or water can of five (5) gallons or less, or drip irrigation. All commercial water users are

requested to reduce water use to the greatest extent possible.

### Water takes center stage in Texas Legislature

Water issues, particularly access and funding, have taken center stage during the 83rd Texas Legislature as state leaders debate the future needs of a growing state.

"Water is important for all Texans, especially farmers and ranchers," said John Ross Copeland, president of Coke-Sterling County Farm Bureau. "Without water, we can't grow our crops or water our livestock, and that means less food for everyone."

Conservation is an important tool to ensure enough water is available to meet the state's increasing population. Legislators, state agencies and organizations like Texas Farm Bureau are encouraging both
