Tire recycling dates set for Coke County

Coke County will sponsor two upcoming tire recycling events, one in Bronte and one in Robert Lee.

The date for Bronte is set for Saturday, March 16, from 9 am until 12 noon. Location for Bronte is the Precinct #2 Yard at 101 N. Randall St. (2nd street behind Stripes).

Robert Lee will hold their event Saturday, March 23, from 9 am until 12 noon, in the parking lot right behind the courthouse at 13 E. 7th St. in Robert Lee.

Residents will be able to dispose of passenger and light truck tires at no charge. No large truck or tractor tires will be accepted due to size restrictions. Commercial businesses may participate as space permits with advance notice and an additional charge.
