**PUBLIC NOTICE OF CHANGES IN ELECTION PRECINCTS**

Pursuant to 42.035, Texas Election Code, the Commissioners Court of Coke County, Texas, herein provides notice of changes in County political boundaries as adopted by the Commissioners Court, and as pre-cleared by the United States Department of Justice on the 31st day of January, 2012.

Interested individuals may review the adopted changes in the office of the County Clerk during regular business hours.

The changes in county election precincts were necessitated by redistricting of County Commissioners Court precincts in compliance with the United States Constitution and 42 U.S.C. 1973, also known as the Voting Rights Act, following the release of 2010 census data. Changes in county election precincts were designed to achieve numerical balance between the four commissioners court precincts, and to insure the voting rights of all citizens of Coke County, Texas.

Tom Sawyer moved to adopt an order calling a bond election in the District on May 12, 2012, and providing for the administration of the election. The motion was seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the minutes of January 19, 2012, seconded by Tracy Allen. All voted for.
