Pecan Tree & Raised Garden Bed Seminar set for April 7

The Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will host a Pecan Tree & Raised Garden Bed seminar for West Texas counties on Thursday, April 7. The event will be broadcasted virtually to several in-person sites across the area for attendees to learn more about managing their pecan trees and the benefits to raised bed gardening.

From getting the best quality and quantity from pecan trees with the least number of inputs to how raised garden beds offer opportunity to succeed with your gardening anywhere there is good sunlight available.

The program will be presented via Zoom at the various host sites across AgriLife Extension's West Region. Registration will begin at 5:30 pm, with the program starting at 6 pm.

Two Texas Department of Agriculture continuing education units - one general, one integrated pest management - will be offered.

The Coke County meeting will be take place at the Robert Lee Rec Hall, which is located at 170 County Park Rd

Dr. Larry Stein, AgriLife Extension Horticulturist will be presenting how to get the best

quality and quantity from pecan trees with the least number of inputs is the goal for most every homeowner. Learn about fertility management and controlling major pecan pests. Gail Eltgroth, Highland Lakes Master Gardener will discuss the benefit of raised garden beds. Interest in starting a home vegetable garden has been spurred on by food scarcity or uncertainty related to the ongoing supply issues. 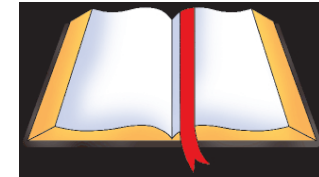
