West Coke County Hospital Board Meeting

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session March 31, 2015. President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order at 9:30 and declared a quorum was present. Other Board members present were Sarah Green, Pat Stephens, Dessie Kendall, and Pat Carwile. Jessica Cason, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting. There were no visitors. The invocation was given by Pat Carwile. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved, and absent Board members were excused.

In the census count, there are currently 31 residents in the facility, as of the meeting date.

In the staffing update, there are currently open positions for ADON, CNAs, and PRN CNAs.

Marketing done in San Angelo included Aging Advocates, Karen Best, Shannon and Community Medical Centers. There will be an ad run in Senior Source Book and Volunteer Appreciation Page. Nursing Home Week is May 10-16. Multiple community and marketing events will be planned, and these will be discussed in the April meeting.

Accounts Receivable/ Collections were discussed. The possibility of changing the system of electronic medical records at the Care Center is currently being explored. The financial statements were discussed and accepted.

Under Capital Improvements, the work on the whirlpool tub addition continues, as quotes and prices are obtained. Fire safety improvements have been scheduled the first week in April to replace multiple smoke detectors in the facility. Quotes are being obtained for upgrades in the facility kitchen.

Regarding building maintenance, gas tests noted needed repairs, and these have been completed. Entry way light repairs have also been completed. Disaster plan updates are being finalized.

Jessica Cason and Sue Ann Nesbit will be attending a Leading Age Conference in Austin, May 17-20.

Future agenda items were discussed, and the date of the next Board meeting will be April 28, 2015. The public is invited and encouraged to attend.
