President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order at 9:30 and declared a quorum was present. Other Board members present were Sarah Green, Pat Stephens, Dessie Kendall, and Pat Carwile. Jessica Cason, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting. There were no visitors. The invocation was given by Pat Minutes from the Carwile. were previous meeting approved, and absent Board members were excused.

In the census count, there are currently 31 residents in the facility, as of the meeting date.

In the staffing update, there are currently open positions for ADON, CNAs, and PRN CNAs.

Marketing done in San Angelo included Aging Advocates, Karen Best, Shannon and Community Medical Centers. There will be an ad run in Senior Source Book and Volunteer Appreciation Page. Nursing Home Week is May 10-16. Multiple community and marketing events will be planned, and these will be discussed in the April meeting.

Accounts Receivable/Collections were discussed. The possibility of changing the system of electronic medical records at the Care Center is currently being explored. The financial statements were discussed and accepted.
