The Bronte ISD Board of Trustees held a Regular Board Meeting on March 20, 2014, at 7 pm. Those in attendance were Shane Kelton, President, David McWright, Paul Williams, Ray Barnett, Blake Braswell, Kay Styles and Alan Richey, Superintendent. Jay Henderson was absent. Also present were David Bedford, Secondary Principal, and Donna Poehls, Elementary Principal. Guests present included Heather Middleton, Maureen Youngblood and Nick Arrott.

The meeting opened in prayer by Ray Barnett

The minutes were approved as read for the February 13, 2014, Board meeting.

There were no audience items. The Principals reported on enrollment: Secondary – 134 with a 94.64% attendance rate and Elementary – 124 with a 96.07% attendance rate. There is a total enrollment of 258.

An update on student activities including Judging contest and District UIL events was presented. Instructional

Materials Allotment and TEKS Certification were approved. All were in favor.

Mr. Richey, Superintendent, presented two calendars for the 2014-2015 school year to the board. The 2014-2015 calendar was tabled.

Mr. Richey reported on the upcoming Board Election. The nominees are Nick Arrott, Riley Coalson, John Seales and Josh Schoenfield. Early Voting begins April 28 and continues through May 6 at the school. Gina McCutchen was designated as early voting clerk. All were in favor.

April and May Board meetings will be held on the 3rd Thursday of the month to facilitate the board election. The Site-Based Retreat was set for April 21 from 5:30 to 8 pm.

A financial update was presented, including YTD Financial report and function 51(Plant Maintenance) concerns. The need and concerns for handrails in the middle gym were discussed as

well.

The Board went into Executive session at 7:37 pm and resumed the Regular meeting at 8:03 pm.

The Board approved the 2014-2015 term contracts for Secondary and Elementary Certified Personnel as presented. All were in favor.

The Board also approved to advertise for an English/Coach/P.E. position.

A motion was made to pay the March 2014 Bills.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
