

The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes.

In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you in the same manner as this notice.

American Cancer Society Relay For Life of Coke County is taking a year off to regroup and refresh. In the meantime, we want to encourage past Coke County Relay For Life

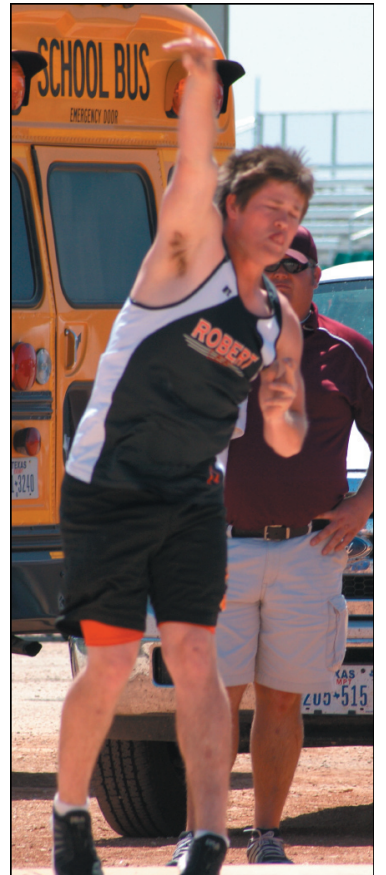
