UIL District Golf Results posted

Varsity Boys

Garden City placed first with a team score of 803 at the District golf tourney in San Angelo and qualified for the regional tournament. Robert Lee came in 2nd with a score of 817 and also qualified for the regional tournament.

Individual scores for Robert Lee were Wade Allen 98-99, 197; Jake Jackson 102-113, 215; Blaine Yanez 114-106, 220; Nathan Scates 95-99, 194; and Bruce Buddin 109-109, 218.

Sterling City came in 3rd with 878, and are the regional alternates. Fourth place went to Blackwell with 904 and Veribest placed 5th with 936.

Robert Lee's Austin Fowler was first place medalist and qualified for the regional tournament. He scored 94-101, 195.
