Stars! The future Stars Sports Day (Young Athletes Programs), offered through SOTX, Special Olympics Texas, was held at Bronte Elementary on Friday, April 3. Pre-K and Kindergarten students participated in this special event.

The Young Athletes Program is a sports play program designed to introduce children ages two to seven to the world of physical activity. Children with and without intellectual disabilities participate together, prior to and regardless of Special Olympics eligibility at age eight. The program utilizes physical activities to develop fundamental motor tracking and eye-hand coordination play. Children build these skills by participating in specific activities on a regular basis. The program concentrates on applying the skills learned through these activities in preparation for Special Olympics or traditional sports competitions. YAP was developed in direct response to requests from families wanting to engage their children in physical fitness. The program is solely based on participation; there is no competition. The skills these children learn will improve all areas of their lives, including participating in future sports competitions.

The 6th grade class was responsible for being in charge of each of the fifteen stations. All students did an awesome job and represented Bronte well!
