# Coke County Commissioners Court meetings held

March 10, 2020

The Coke County Commissioners Court met in regular session at the Coke County Courthouse on March 10, 2020. Those in attendance included County Judge Hal Spain, Commissioner Precinct 1 Donald Robertson, Commissioner Precinct 3 Marshall Millican, Commissioner Precinct 4 Joe Sefcik and County/District Clerk Monica Reyes.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag and prayer was offered by Judge Spain.

Judge Spain announced the presence of a quorum. Commissioner Williams was absent.

Commissioner Millican moved to approve the minutes for February 25, 2020, as written. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Treasurer Therese Emert. Commissioner Sefcik moved to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented and was seconded by Commissioner Millican. The motion carried.

The Extension Report was not available.

Sheriff Wayne McCutchen presented the Sheriff's Report.

The Tax Collector's Report was presented by Randi Hardesty.

County/District Clerk Monica Reyes presented her report.

Constable Precinct 1 Marty Boyd's report was presented by Judge Hal Spain.

The Justice of the Peace Report was presented by Russell Johnson.

There was no DR Report.

Judge Spain presented the Trapper's Report.

No action was taken on the burn ban.

Texas Department of Transportation representative Nic DeHoyos presented the agreement for the Commissioners Court to review and sign.

Commissioner Millican made a motion to declare items for salvage. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Sefcik, carried.

Commissioner Sefcik made a

motion to approve the donation of a computer from the Coke County Library to the Coke County Historical Commission. Commissioner Millican seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Commissioner Sefcik made a motion to approve the bond for Martha Ratliff. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.

Commissioner Millican made a motion to approve the request from Frontier Communications to construct a communication line within the right-of-way of a county road in Coke County. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.

Commissioner Millican made a motion to approve the one-year contract with Snider Technology to provide router and firewall protection for Coke County Annex in Bronte to be paid out of JP Technology Funds. Commissioner Sefcik seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Commissioner Robertson made a motion to approve the

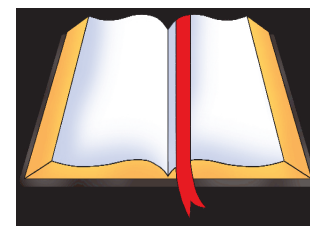
