On Sunday, March 29, 2020, President Trump extended his 15 day program of social distancing and other recommendations until April 30, 2020. At presstime, Texas was not under a "Shelter in Place" order. Although all of the restrictions imposed by Governor Abbott March 13, 2020, and March 19, 2020, remain in place. These include no gatherings of more than 10 people, six feet apart and limiting restaurants to take-out and delivery only. Schools remain closed and nursing homes remain locked down.

With the multiple cases in Tom Green County, large grocery and big box stores must go to one entrance allowing monitoring where only 100 customers may be in the store at any one time.

The Coke County Courthouse in Robert Lee and the Justice of the Peace office in Bronte are closed to the public. However, most of the offices still have employees working and can be reached by phone or email. The numbers for these offices are:
