Early voting to be held through April 27

Early voting for the May 1, 2021, local government entity elections begins Monday, April 19, 2021, and will continue through April 27, 2021. Only two local entities will have to have an election due to contested ballots - City of Bronte and Bronte ISD. The other four local government entities were able to cancel their

elections.

The City of Bronte has openings for three council positions. These are two year terms. The offices are currently held by Ron Cooper, Stormy Vaughn and Santiago Rodriguez. Tomas Jowers, Clabe Webb, RA Morris and Zachary Davidson are the candidates on this year's ballot.

Bronte ISD will hold an election to elect three members to the Board of Trustees. These are three year terms currently held by Ashley Braswell, Terry Queen and Blake Braswell. Ashley Braswell and Terry Queen have filed for re-election. They will be joined on the ballot by Lynsey Coalson and Dustin Bilyeu.

Early voting for both elections will be held at Bronte City Hall.
