Those in attendance were: Paul Williams, Blake Braswell, Shane Kelton, Ray Barnett, Kay Styles, David McWright, Jay Henderson and Alan Richey, Superintendent. Also present were David Bedford, Secondary Principal and Donna Poehls, Elementary Principal. Several guests were also present. The meeting opened in prayer by David McWright

The minutes were approved for the March 21, 2013, Board meeting.

There were no audience items.

The Principals reported the following enrollment: Elementary - 128, Secondary - 136. Total enrollment - 264.

Ms. Poehls reported next years projected Elementary enrollment at 112.
