Lady Steers head to State

The Lady Steers golf team qualified for the State Tournament, to be held at Lions Golf Course in Austin on May 2 and 3. This is a result of their second place finish in the Region II-A golf tournament, held at the Shady Oaks Golf Course in Baird.

The Lady Steers fired total. The 363 second day total was by far the Lady Steers' best team round of the year. It also moved the Lady Steers from 3rd place in the team standings after day 1, to tie for 2nd with Paducah, a tie the Lady Steers broke by winning a team playoff for the silver medal. Hamlin took the team title with rounds of 372-373-745 total.

RLHS Senior Jordan Gartman paced the Lady Steers with rounds of 76-75 for a 151 total, the best by a Lady Steer in recent history and good for the runner-up medal in the medalist race.
