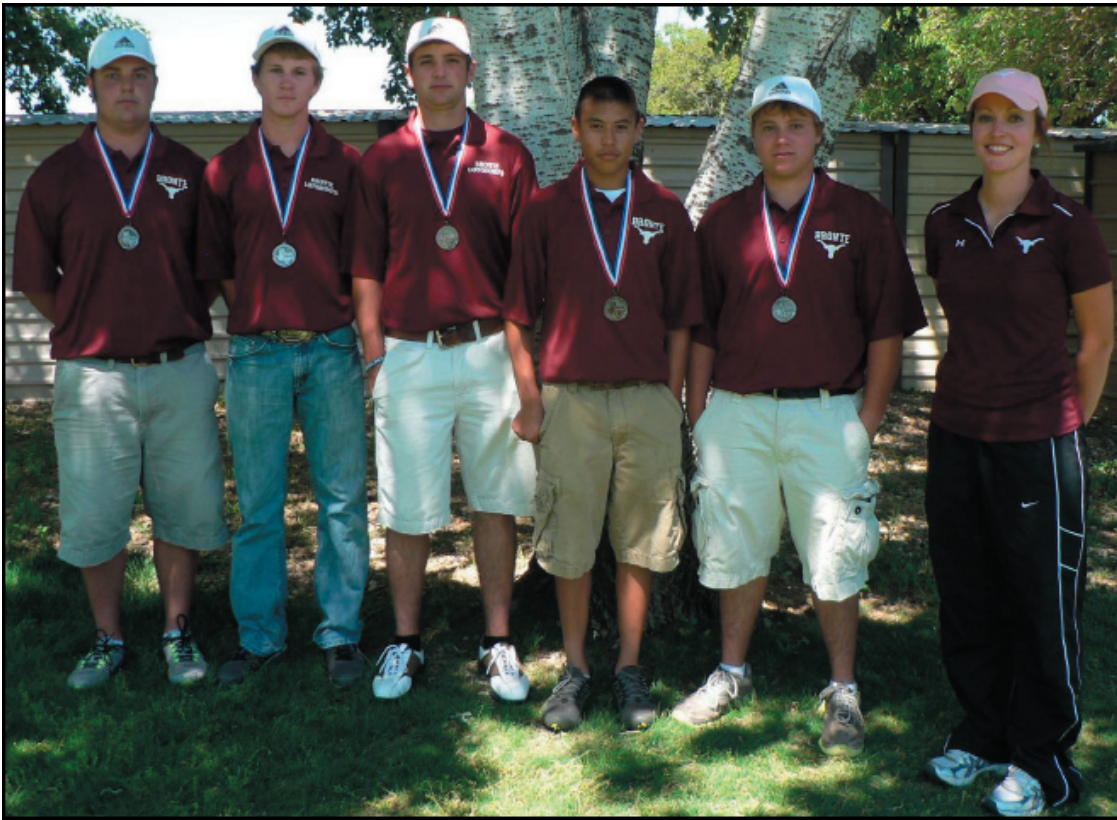


BRONTE SCHOOL NEWS
