Prospective Pre-K students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2017, to be eligible for the $2017-$ 2018 school year.
Documents needed for Headstart will be proof of all family income, proof of age, child's shot record, SNAP (if applicable) and proof of Medicaid, CHIP, or private health insurance.

Required documentation for enrollment will include birth certificate, social security card, and current immunization records Registration packets may also be picked up at the Elementary office anytime from 8 am to 4 pm.
