Current Bronte ISD student counts are as follows: 243 total students, including 151 in elementary, 34 in 7th - 8th grades, and 55 in 9th - 12th grades. ADA is at 98.96%.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Siler gave an update on ISD's financial Bronte information. Finances are very interesting right now. Mr. Siler did a "hold harmless" on a template for a semester due to

A passing score is 60, Bronte our numbers being less than the state required. Mr. Siler was able to look at federal money and was almost able to fund the 2nd grade teacher out of federal funds. He advised we might possibly see a second round of ESSR funds due to COVID. He is very excited about the increasing enrollment. He is also hoping for a 95% tax return. Mr. Siler also let the board know BISD is seeing more special education students than previous years. Mr. Siler also gave an update on maintenance. There was an AC unit that was replaced costing approximately \$7,500. There is a roof leak and Mr. Siler received a free estimate advising the roof on the high school end is in need of replacing, which could approximately cost \$8,500. Martin is continuing to patch where he can and there have been no leaks but will need to be replaced. Mr. Siler is slowly getting estimates from roofing companies. Mr. Siler was going to send a bus to auction but was not sure if another auction will be held. He is going to see if an engine

David McWright made a motion to order the school board election and was seconded by John Seales. The motion passed with a vote of 7 - 0.

Terry Queen made a motion, with Jodie Arrott seconding, to designate Laurie Austin as Early Voting Clerk. The motion passed with a vote of 7 - 0.
