Robert Lee schedules election

The City of Robert Lee will hold a general election on May 10, 2014 to elect a Mayor and Two City Council members. Incumbent, John Jacobs, is the unopposed candidate on the ballot for Mayor. There are three candidates for the two City Council positions; Manuel Abalos, and Incumbent members, Sid Burns and Richard Johnson.

Registered voters of the City of Robert Lee may vote early by personal appearance during the period of April 28-May 5, 2014 between the hours of 8:00a.m.-5:00p.m., Monday - Thursday

and between the hours of 8:00a.m. - 1:00p.m. on Friday. The location of the polling place for early voting and election day is the Coke County Courthouse, Clerks' Office, at 13 East 7th Street.
