**RLISD Board meeting held**

The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met in regular session on Thursday, February 21, 2019, at 5 pm.

Members present included Wes Washam, George Grim, Tom Sawyer, Beverly Sinclair, and Jeffie Roberts. Members absent were Irma Torres and Erin Oleksiuk.

The meeting was called to order by President Washam at 5 pm with a quorum of members present.

The invocation and pledge were led by George Grim.

Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve the minutes of January 24, 2019, and was seconded by George Grim. All were for.

Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve the financial reports as presented by Robin Allen and to approve the bills. She was seconded by Tom Sawyer and all were for.

David O'Dell gave the high school report; enrollment for grades 7-12 was 107 and an attendance rate of 94.7% for January. Lee McCown gave the elementary principals report; elementary enrollment for January was 160 students and 95.1% attendance rate.

Supt. Hood recommended to sign the engagement letter/agreement to secure Eckert & Company, LLP CPA for the District Audit for year ending August 31, 2019. George Grim made the motion to approve the recommendation and was seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All were for.

Supt. Hood recommended the Depository Contract Extension with Robert Lee State Bank for September 1, 2019, through August 31, 2021. Tom Sawyer made the motion to approve the recommendation and was seconded by George Grim. All were for.

Supt. Hood recommended awarding the bid to Apple Inc. for elementary tablets for a total of \$39,240. Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve the recommendation. She was seconded by Tom Sawyer and all for.

Supt. Hood recommended awarding the bid to Southern

Computer Warehouse for 94 Dell Chromebooks for a total of \$28,186.84. George Grim made a motion to approve the recommendation and was seconded by Tom Sawyer. All were for.

Supt. Hood gave his report on facilities, enrollment numbers, budget, track meets, and public meeting on the Bond Issue.

The Board entered into closed session at 6:02 pm and reconvened into open session at 6:16 pm.
