tural producers use environmentally sensitive land for conservation benefits. Producers enrolled in CRP plant long-term, resourceconserving covers to control soil erosion, improve water and air quality and develop wildlife habitat. In return, FSA provides participants with rental payments and cost-share assistance. Contract duration is between 10 to 15 years. Accepted contracts for sign-up will begin on October 1, 2011.

FSA accepting applications

The Farm Service Agency (FSA) is now accepting applications for Emergency Farm Loans resulting from drought occuring from March 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.

Mitchell & Taylor

Counties have been named as primary counties where eligible farmers may qualify for FSA EM loan assistance. Nolan, Sterling, Coke, Fisher & Scurry Counties have been named as contiguous counties where eligible farmers may qualify for FSA EM loan assistance. Farm Loan Manager, Justin B. Holland, ask farmers who want to apply for emergency loans to submit their applications as soon as possible. The deadline for applications is 11/28/2011, but if farmers wait too long, a backlog will develop and cause delays.

Generally, farmers who have lost 30 percent of their production due to designated disaster are elegible for emergency loans. The FSA office is located at 103 W. Florida Avenue in Sweetwater, Texas.
