

Rabies Clinic set for Robert Lee

Coke County 4-H will sponsor a Rabies Clinic Tuesday, April 12, 2016, from 3:30 pm to 6 pm at the South end of the Show Barn in the Robert Lee Park.

Dr. Travis Arledge of Pioneer Vet Clinic in Winters will be the Veterinarian in charge. All pets four months of age and older should be immunized and rabies vaccinations should be given annually.

Rabies vaccinations worming will be offered. Other immunizations for dogs will include Distemoper/Parvo/ Corona, Rattlesnake, Parvo (under 12 weeks of age), and Kennel Cough. Distemper/ Leukemia shots will be available for cats. Horses will be able to obtain their rabies, West Nile/ Vewt, flu/rhino, and rattlesnake vaccinations. Paste worming with Zimectrin Gold will also be offered for horses.
