the support and involvement of the teachers and school administration.

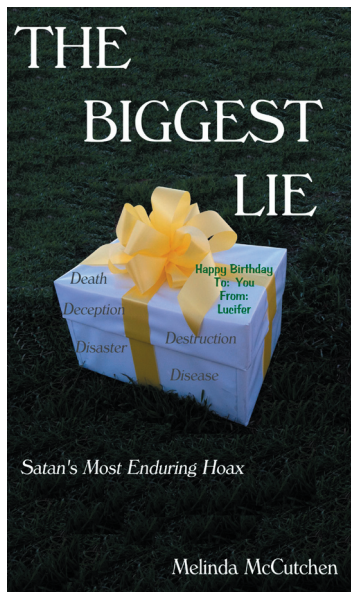
Relay for Life set for May 17-18
