The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session Monday, April 30, 2012. President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order at 9:40 am, and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Mary Bessent, Sarah Green, Pat Stephens, Dessie Kendall, and Patsy Cason. Also present were Roger Alexander, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, Business Office Mgr.

Mary Bessent gave the invocation. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved, and there

were no absent Board members.

In the staffing update, Roger informed the Board there is currently enough staff to fill the needs of the residents at the facility. Roger also reported there are currently 10 residents in the Alzheimer's Unit, and 49 residents total in the Care Center as of the meeting date. Under Capital Improvements, concerning the future remodeling of the Alzheimer's Unit, there was a meeting with the construction engineer this past week. Several items were discussed toward completion of the plans and hopefully, construction will begin around the 1st of July. The new floor coverings have been completed, and the new windows for the front lobby have been ordered. They will be installed upon arrival. Gary Payne has the fountain installed in the courtyard in front of the facility, and is in the process of laying the rock. The completed project will be beautiful, and will really update and enhance the looks of the front entry. Gary is doing an excellent job.

Accounts Receivable was discussed. The financial statement was discussed and accepted.

Roger informed the Board the Silver Chair Learning online inservice assistance, which has been implemented at the facility, is working well.

The Board broke for lunch from 12:00 to 1:00.

After lunch, the Board discussed policy for the Nurses' station, the use of the time clock, meal tickets for employees, and Friday dress code. The Board went into Executive Session from 2:12

pm to 3:00 pm. After returning to regular session, the Board voted to extend salaried positions to include ADON, Assistant Business Office Mgr., Dietary Mgr., Operations Mgr., Activity Director, Human Resources Director, as well as those who currently hold salaried positions.

Future agenda items were discussed and the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting will be May 29, 2012. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend.
