Robert Lee ISD Board minutes posted

The Robert Lee ISD Board of Directors met in regular session at 5 pm Tuesday, April 20, 2017. The meeting was called to order by President Washam.

Members present were Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, George Grim, Tom Sawyer, Irma Torres, Beverly Sinclair and Erin Oleksiuk.

Tom Sawyer gave the invocation and led the pledge.

George Grim made a motion to approve the minutes of March 28, 2017, and April 4, 2017, seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve the financial reports as presented by Robin Allen and to approve the bills, seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Supt. Hood gave the high school and elementary reports; enrollment for grades 7-12 was 107 and attendance rate was 95% for the month of March. Enrollment for elementary was 174 students and 95% attendance rate.

Supt. Hood recommended signing the agreement with Eligibility Tracking Calculators (ETC) for the 2017-2018 school year. Tom Sawyer made the motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Irma Torres. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended signing the Lease Renewal with Concho Valley Council of Governments for the 2017-2018 school year. George Grim made the motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Supt. Hood gave his report on enrollment numbers, budget update, facilities update, graduation, and summer hours.

The Board adjourned from Open Session at 5:15 pm and entered into Closed Session at 5:16 pm. The Board reconvened into Open Session at 5:41 pm.

Supt. Hood recommended to renew term contract employees for 2017-18 as presented and to renew probationary employees as presented. A motion was made by Erin Oleksiuk to accept Supt. Hood's recommendation, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for. They are listed below.

Supt. Hood recommended Kellye Duncan as K-12 Counselor for a one year 11 month contract. George Grim made a motion to accept this recommendation, seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended hiring Mandi McCown as an elementary teacher with a one year 10 month probationary contract for 2017-2018 school year. Erin Oleksiuk made a motion, seconded by Irma Torres, to approve this recommendation. All voted for.

Supt. Hood read resignation letters from Michael Thomas and Joel Natividad.

The next regular board meeting will be Thursday, May 18, 2017, at 5 pm. The meeting was adjourned at 5:46 pm.

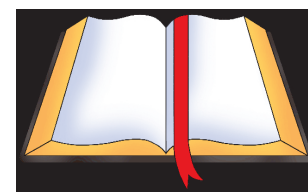
