The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met in regular session Thursday, April 23, 2014, at 5 pm. The meeting was called to order by President Washam.

Present were Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, Beverly Sinclair, Erin Oleksiuk, Tom Sawyer, Irma Torres and George Grim.

The Invocation and pledge were led by Jeffie Roberts.

Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve the minutes of the

March 20, 2014, meeting. The motion was seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to accept the financial report as presented by Robin Allen and to pay the bills, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for.

Wayne Simpson gave the elementary report. Elementary enrollment for March was 136 students and 95.6% attendance rate. David O'Dell gave the high school report. High School enrollment for grades 7-12 was 100 and attendance rate was 96.1% for the month of March.

Supt. Hood recommended signing an agreement with Interquest Detection Canines of West Texas for 2014-2015 school year. Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve this recommendation, seconded by Irma Torres. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended that Board Policy EIF (Local) be

adopted as presented. Erin Oleksiuk made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by George Grim. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended that Local Policy Update 99 be approved as presented. Irma Torres made a motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Supt. Hood gave his respective report on enrollment numbers, budget process, facilities update, graduation, and summer hours.

The Board adjourned open session at 5:20 pm and entered into closed session at 5:21 pm. The Board reconvened into open session at 7:29 pm.

Supt. Hood read resignation letters from Wayne Alexander and Bree Sherwood. Jeffie Roberts made a motion to accept their resignations, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for.
