County Relay For Life was held on April 29-30, 2011 in Robert Lee. The event is designed to celebrate survivors, remember those who have battled cancer and to fight back against this dreaded disease plus raise money and awareness for the American Cancer Society. This year over \$25,600 was raised to help support the ACS's efforts in the areas of research, education, and patient services. Despite the West Texas wind, seventy cancer survivors were registered and 370 luminaria bags in honor and in memory of those affected by cancer lined the track. Over 1,000 canned goods were collected to be used in the luminaria bags and then donated to the Coke County Food Pantry.

The survivors started off the Relay by walking the opening lap. The caregivers began walking at the same time in the opposite direction around the track. When they met up with the survivors, they turned and all finished the lap together. Next all the teams walked a lap to get the Relay started! After that team members took turns and at least one member from each team walked continuously throughout the night.

The Road to Recovery Race was held at 8 pm. This represented the Road to Recovery program that the American Cancer Society has to drive cancer patients to and from treatments.
