The meeting was called to order at 5 pm by President Bedford.

A quorum was established.

There were no public comments.

Food Handlers Class available on request

The "Texas Food Establishment Rules (TFER)" now requires all food employees to complete an accredited food handler training program within 60 days of employment.

A food handlers course accredited by the Texas Department of State Health Services is being offered by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, Coke County Extension Office. Food Safety: It's In Your Hands is available upon request.

This 1-2-hour course will now be required for all food service employees to help promote the service of safe food. The certificate is good for 2 years and is valid anywhere in the State of Texas. The course is a basic overview of food safety practices that are necessary to ensure that safe food is served at your establishment. Practices discussed include good personal hygiene, cross contamination, and time and temperature abuse.

To register for the course, call the Coke County Extension office at 325-453-2461. Registration can also be done inperson the day of the course.
